places in the county of Graham one
of which was at the place where this
Court is held - stating the name of
the deceased, the name of the applicant
and the term of this Court - at which
the application would be heard, the
same having been given at least ten
days before the hearing and that the notice
was in all respects according to law
and it being proved by the Affidavit of
the petitioner that the said Isaac J. Stevens
died on the tenth day of August - 1885 -
intestate, in the county of Graham
Territory of Arizona that he was a resident
of said county at the time of his death
and that he left estate in the said county
and within the jurisdiction of this Court
That the said petitioner is legally competent
and is a son of said deceased and

therefore entitled to letters of administration of said estate his Mother the widow of said deceased having in writing relinquished her right thereto in his favor.

That the personal ^{property} belonging to said estate is of the value of One thousand dollars or thereabouts, and that the estate and effects for or in respect to which letters of administration are applied for as aforesaid do not exceed the value of twenty five hundred dollars.

And no person interested in said estate appearing to contest the application of said petitioner.

It is ordered that letters of Administration of the estate of the said Isaac J Stevens deceased issue to the said petitioner Charles E Stevens upon his taking the oath and filing a bond according to law in the sum of two thousand dollars.
